IMPORTANT NOTES / PLS READ

TENNIS and SWIMMING are the only K-1 classes that require pre-registration during Semester enrollment (pls make sure you select the respective Weekday(s) when you sign up online. ** Extra Fee added to Semester Tuition.

Students have access to all of the other activities listed above on a rotating basis. There is no extra fee for those classes and no need to make selections during enrollment. Group supervisors are responsible for daily adjustments depending on children's preferences, group size, weather conditions, etc.

* TENNIS accepts all levels and provides equipment (no racquet needed). Children are grouped by skill level.

* SWIMMING is offered in partnership with the McBurney YMCA Aquatics Dept. Children are tested and grouped by skill-level. Students are escorted to the pool by our staff and dismissed from the McBurney Y (not from PS 3) between 5:45 and 6:00pm. Address: 125 West 14th Street. ** Swim Classes begin in October (children enrolled in Swimming are offered alternative activities during the month of September).

* Language workshops - Chinese and Spanish - offer an immersive experience in the new language and introduce children to different aspects of its speakers' culture and traditions. Activities include sing-alongs, games, rhymes, play-acting, dance, cooking, calligraphy, crafts, etc.

* Chess Club provides a relaxed setting where students can engage in supervised play, puzzles and friendly matches.

* Chess Masters classes group students by skill-level.
