How will I get my PS3 Family ID?

Two PS3 Family IDs will be distributed by classroom teachers at Meet the Teacher Night on September 13. If you are unable to attend that evening, the IDs will be available from the teacher.

If you have more than one child at PS3, the PS3 Family ID will go to the classroom of the youngest child in the school.

The school safety agent knows me. Do I still need to show a PS3 Family ID?

All parents must show this ID to enter the school, even if you think the agent knows you. If you forget your ID at home, you may show another form of identification and sign in.

What if I lose or forget my PS3 Family ID?

If you lose the ID or need another one (for a caregiver, for example), you may purchase one from Sheri in the Main Office.

Can I enter the school to eat breakfast with my child?

Pre-K/K/1 parents may continue to eat breakfast with their children from 7:55-8:15. Parents of students above 1st grade (2/3/4/5) will not be permitted to stay for breakfast. However, we will have school staff there to tend to your children.

What if I need to drop a form off in the main office?

During arrival times, you should show your PS3 Family ID to the school safety agent, or sign in with other identification, and then come up to the main office. At other times, you should sign in with the school safety agent before proceeding to the main office.

What if I need to drop off something for my child during the day?

You should show identification and sign in with the school safety agent before proceeding to the main office, where the classroom will be notified. You should **not** go directly to a classroom.

What if I need to pick up my child early?

Early pick-up should be reserved for emergencies and must be done before 2:15 p.m. After that, no children will be dismissed until 2:40 pm. You should show identification and sign in with the school safety agent before proceeding to the main

office, where the classroom will be notified. You should **not** go directly to a classroom.

What if we are late to school?

Lateness is disruptive to the entire community, but your child suffers most. Please make every effort to arrive on time. Late passes are issued in the lobby beginning at 8:25 a.m. At this time, you will not be able to bring your child to the classroom. A staff member will be on hand to bring younger children to class. If you arrive after the office staff has left the lobby, the child needs to get a late pass in the office. If she or he does not do this, she or he will be marked absent. School staff will bring younger children from the office to their classroom.
